

360 Meet the animals on Pathfinder Ranch's Betsy's Farm: Transcript

0:01 Welcome to the alpaca and goat pen. Alpacas and goats are both herd animals, so they are most comfortable living together.

0:19 Alpacas are smaller than llamas and were bred for their fur. In contrast, llamas were bred to be herd animals.

0:32 The dark brown alpaca is named Charlie Brown, and the lighter alpaca is Linus.

0:56 This is our alpine goat, Izzy.

1:11 Hiding in the shed is our fainting goat, Beau.

1:17 When fainting goats are surprised or frightened, their muscles stiffen up, causing them to fall over for about 3 seconds. So we'll leave him alone.

1:37 Alpacas can spit at you when frightened or upset, so we try to keep them as comfortable as possible.

1:48 Let's see if Izzy is interested in eating any hay.

2:04 Nope :(

3:39 Our alpacas love to play in the water. So, let's see what happens.

4:23 Let's go see how some other animals react to the water.

4:30 These are our miniature Vietnamese potbelly pigs.

4:34 This pig is named Ziggy, and he loves playing in the mud.

6:06 These two smaller pigs are the females, Betty (gray), and Harriett (black).

6:26 Betty loves to be scratched. Harriett is shy.
